 Farmer & blacksmith. Died of black fever.
 REVOLUTIONARY WAR. 8th Co., 6th Battalion, Lancaster Co. Militia.

Married, 27 Apr 1790 in Cumberland Valley & later moved west. Wife, Nancy Penelope YOUNG. 1773-18 Apr 1817. Age 44. From Baltimore.Died of black fever. Wife died 3 days after husband. Both buried, Memorial Park, Indiana, Pa.
